We design and implement protection and education programs aiming to offer each individual the assistance and opportunities they need to thrive. By connecting with local initiatives and institutional efforts, we foster inclusive responses in complex and volatile environments.

Better Days is a registered AMKE (non-profit) organisation in Greece.

Better Days is driven by the conviction that every child should be given a fair chance to lead a dignified life, realise their potential and fight for their dreams. We stand up for this with courage, compassion, and tireless commitment.

About Gekko

Gekko in Athens is a non-formal education centre offering personalized education for children and young people (ages 15-24) affected by displacement. Gekko's context-aware services are designed to address the specific needs of displaced learners and dismantle barriers that impede learning. Supported by strong referral pathways with like-minded organizations, Gekko acts as an essential bridge service to meet student needs beyond the classroom and promote integration into the Athens community. Gekko not only follows best practices in the field of displacement and education, but serves as a lab for their further development. Over 800 children and young people have benefited from Gekko's services in our first year of operations.

Volunteering with Better Days

Better Days is a small and dynamic organisation looking to recruit people who are passionate about humanitarian work, understand its risks and complexities, and are interested in investing in their role long-term. We are a quality-driven organisation determined to provide grassroots, holistic and effective solutions to support the integration and de-victimization of displaced communities in Europe, focusing on refugee education and empowerment of youth. Our colleagues come from all over the world, and our official business language is English. The ideal candidate will be inducted and trained to be able to perform in their roles. Comprehensive materials related to the responsibilities at Gekko will be provided, ensuring the volunteer is well-equipped. Additionally, continuous supervision and support will be offered throughout their engagement with Better Days.

Role Description

Volunteering for a local non-profit/humanitarian organisation requires versatility and excellent organisational and time-management skills. Desired qualities include a strong passion for education, human rights, and inclusive teaching; a positive, can-do attitude; excellent teamwork skills; a performance-driven mindset; and a respectful, creative, and kind approach to working with others.

The Greek Teaching volunteer/intern will support the Academic department. They will assist with the development and delivery of engaging Greek language lessons tailored to the diverse needs and abilities of our students. In addition, they will design and facilitate workshops that respond to the needs of Gekko's students, extending the organization's educational offerings. The intern/volunteer will also help create a supportive and inclusive learning environment that promotes academic growth and emotional resilience among students from diverse backgrounds, including those with exceptionalities, enabling them to thrive in a multicultural setting.

The supervisor/technical point for this role is the Staff Greek Teacher and/or Head of Academics.

Main Responsibilities

- Assist with curriculum design and development if needed.
- Prepare syllabi, lesson plans, assignments, and teaching materials for all educational levels if needed.
- Maintain daily attendance records and collect student feedback.
- Provide support for school administration if needed.
- Teach in various group sizes and offer one-on-one tutoring.
- Conduct in-person and online classes as required.
- Monitor and assess student progress according to individual plans and report to the Head of Academics at scheduled intervals.

Basic Requirements

- Being 18 years or older.
- Eligibility to legally reside in Greece. (Please note that while we are able to provide an invitation letter for your visa application, we are unable to offer any additional support beyond that.)
- Having a clean criminal record.
- Being available for at least eight weeks.
- Previous experience in teaching or tutoring.
- Certification in teaching Greek as a second language is preferred.
- Being fluent in the English language, the organisation's official working language.
- Candidates with experience working or volunteering with children, youth, and people affected by displacement will be prioritised.
- Multilingual candidates with fluency in French, Farsi, Arabic, and Urdu are prioritised.
- Confident users of G-Suite.
- Financially independent and self-sufficient.
- Ability to issue their own international travel and medical insurance.
